State Tax Relief for Toolmakers

To help the small toolmaker stay afloat in these tough economic times, the state of Michigan created the Tool and Die Recovery Zones program in 2004, granting small shops the ability to operate nearly free of state or local taxes for up to 15 years. The first eight zones encompass 33 companies, and the Michigan Economic Development Corp. is now accepting applications for a second round of recovery zones. To qualify, the designated property must be leased or owned by a qualified tool and die business and used primarily for tool and die operations. The company must have fewer than 50 full-time employees and be willing to enter into a qualified collaborative agreement with other qualified tool and die businesses, which creates synergies such as standardized processes and management methods.


